Two Wrapped Twining Basketry Workshops with June Ward from Neah Bay



We are lucky to have June Ward bringing her expertise to share with us in February 2012. She has woven baskets, hats and tiny jewelry using the traditional wrapped twining techniques utilized by Makah in their basketry technology. One of her hats is in the Burke Museum. Both workshops will feature a choice of projects using cedar or sweetgrass spokes, twined with beargrass or chebup (a native basketry sedge). The focus will be on preparing these flat plant fibers for weaving, and on the wrapped twine technique, including joining and changing colors. The Beginner workshop will feature rows of wrapped twining on the sides of a small basket. The project is designed to be finished in one day. The Intermediate workshop will offer more scope for folks who already have cedar and twining experience, and several project choices will be available.

Cost for the workshops are as follows:
Beginner – \$50 Instructor fee plus \$30 materials fee

Intermediate - \$90 Instructor fee plus \$50 materials fee

No experience is necessary to register for the Beginner workshop. Students enrolling in the Intermediate workshop should have some cedar experience and definitely be comfortable with twining.

The Workshops will be held at the Moshier Art Center at 430 S 156th St. Burien, WA

June Ward Wrapped Twining Workshops February 10-12 2012, Moshier Art Center, Burien

Registration begins 12/28/11 and is first come, first served. Class enrollment will be assessed February 3, 2012 to determine if class minimums are met and class(es) will be held. \$50 deposit is due with your registration to hold your place. Lunch info will be sent out with your confirmation. Class notifications will be handled via email. If you wish to receive confirmation via mail, please include a SASE with your registration.

CANCELLATION POLICY:

*Your workshop fee & materials fee, less a \$5.00 administration fee, will be refunded provided that the registrar receives notification by telephone by **February 2, 2012**, followed up in writing.*

*From **February 3, 2012** on: For **cancellations**,*

1) the same fees will be retained as above,

2) the original materials fee for each workshop will be retained by the instructor, and

3) if the workshop size drops below the minimum of 9 students, the original workshop fee will not be refunded.

No refunds without notification to the registrar by telephone followed by writing.

On the day of your class, arrive between 8:00 and 8:30 a.m. to pay any outstanding fees, sign in and get settled. Classes will run from 9:00 to 5:00 with a half-hour lunch break at 12:30pm. You may bring your own lunch or pre-pay for lunch (lunch info to be sent with your confirmation). Morning and afternoon snacks will be provided as well as coffee, tea and bottled water. Refrigerator is available.

Students should bring the following tools: small bucket or bowl, small towel, sharp scissors, awl, a large eyed tapestry needle, sharp pocket knife, a few clothespins, an apron or old shirt and a bear grass sizing tool if you have one. A list of tools will also be sent with your workshop confirmation. Instructor will have some tools available for student use during workshops.
