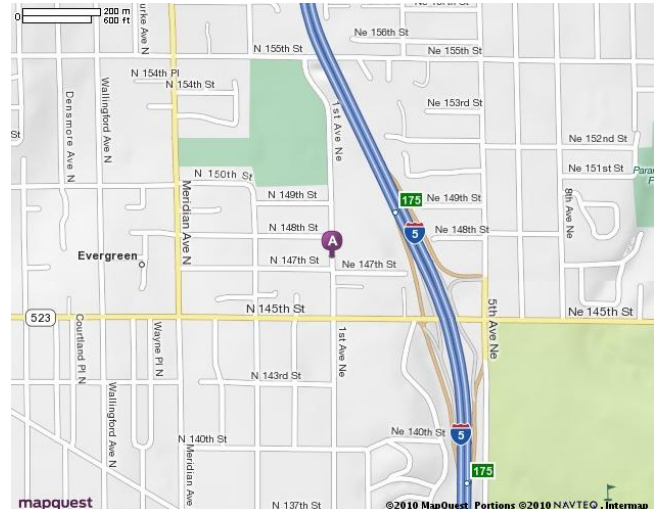

Driving Directions to the new meeting location

If driving southbound on I-5:

- Exit I-5 at EXIT #175
- Turn right onto NE 145th and travel 0.1 mile to 1st Ave NE (traffic signal)
- Turn right at 1st Ave NE and travel 0.1 mile
- The church is on the right with the entrance directly across from 148th Street NE

If driving northbound on I-5:

Exit I-5 at EXIT #175

Travel north toward NE 145th

Turn left onto 5th Ave NE (this will be a slight left as the ramp approaches 5th Ave NE at an angle.

Turn left onto NE 14th and travel 0.2 miles

Turn right onto 1st Ave NE and travel 0.1 mile

The church is on the right with the entrance directly across from 148th Street NE

Note: The signage is confusing as there are two churches that share the same driveway.

ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

If driving north on 1st Avenue NE

About 147th Street, on the right (east side of street), you will see a white, well-lit sign "Shoreline Unitarian Universalist Church." **This is not the driveway.** Continue past this sign a few more feet and on the right, you will see a green and white, well-lit sign with Korean writing on the top that says: "Philippi Presby Church". Turn right, into the driveway **in front of** the green and white sign. The Unitarian Church buildings and parking lot are on the right.

If driving south on 1st Avenue NE

Signs are difficult to see because they are not well-lit. The first sign on the left is well-lit, "Aegis Living." Continue past this sign and soon there is a red sign on the left that is very difficult to see, "Vineyard Community Church." Continue past this sign a few feet and on the left, you will see a telephone pole and a spotlight that shines in your face and a shadowy sign. Immediately **after** the spotlight and dark sign, turn left into the driveway of the church. The Unitarian Church buildings and parking lot are on the right. If you see a well-lit white sign on the left, "Shoreline Unitarian Universalist Church," you have gone too far.
